Kitten Vaccination/Care Schedule

- 8 weeks old: FVRCP #8 week (distemper) vaccine
Fecal exam
Deworming
Flea/tick prevention – *optional if indoor only*
- 12 weeks old: FVRCP #12 week vaccine
FeLV/FIV blood test
FeLV #1 vaccine – *recommended*
Rabies (1 year) vaccine
Fecal exam
Deworming
Flea/tick prevention – *optional if indoor only*
- 16 weeks old: FVRCP 1 yr vaccine
FeLV #2 vaccine – *recommended*
Fecal exam (if previous were positive)
Deworming (if previous were positive)
Flea/tick prevention – *optional if indoor only*
Heartworm prevention (optional, but if so give every month, all year)
- 4-6 months old: Neuter or spay +/- front declaw
Microchipping
- 1 year old: FeLV (1 year) - (recommended booster for indoor-only & yearly for outdoor/indoor)

****Definitions:**

FeLV = Feline Leukemia Virus

FIV = Feline Immunodeficiency Virus

FVRCP vaccine includes:

Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, Panleukopenia (Distemper), & Chlamydia Psittaci
